Hygiene Programme Success

The Hygiene programme in schools is now an established programme with the latest being held in the remote Village of Ghachok. Sarita ran the programme over two days for the students of the school, with teachers and parents also getting involved. Hygiene is very poor in these villages and so giving them the knowledge of proper sanitation and also simple things like how to brush their teeth properly can make a massive difference! At the end of the hygiene programme the children receive, tooth brushes, soap, clothes soap, comb, nail clippers and the school receives bins, sweepers and other hygiene related items.

In early December we received a request from Gorkha to fund 200 jumpers for the younger children at Mahendra Jyoti and Bal Mandir Schools. The supplier also kindly gave another 25 jumpers for free! Laxman and Sarita told us 'the children were so happy to get the jumpers and we hope that it will give them warmth and love towards we/you people.' The local media was also present at the event, and they even had a small coverage in their local newspaper.



These jumpers are essential for the poorer school children as the winters in Gorkha are very cold and there is no heating so again, a little is making such a difference.
